Pennsbury Scholarship Foundation Awards \$185,000 to 72 Students in 2023



PSF's Legacy of Giving

The Pennsbury Scholarship Foundation awarded \$185,000 to 72 Pennsbury graduates for the 2023-24 school year. At a reception held in PHS West's Keller Hall in June, the PSF Board of Directors and several endowed namesake scholarship donor families presented awards to the students, who attend 46 different colleges and universities located throughout the U.S.

The evening began with a welcome message from PSF President Alan Chrzanowski. He provided some background information about the Foundation and announced that five new endowed namesake scholarships would be awarded during the evening.

Mr. Chrzanowski spoke about the legacy of giving that has led the PSF's endowed namesake scholarship program to grow to fifty awards. Each one is a lasting tribute to

the life of someone with a connection to Pennsbury, just as this year's recipients will forever be connected to Pennsbury—a connection that will grow stronger as the recipients repay their PSF loans and pay it forward to future graduates.

Taking Time

Following his remarks, Mr. Chrzanowski introduced Pennsbury High School teacher and Girls Basketball Coach, Frank Sciolla, as the keynote speaker. Mr. Sciolla spoke to the audience about the concept of time. He talked about the various commitments competing for their time, and the amount of juggling that the students have done up until this point in their lives to be so successful. As busy as they are, the students have made the time to prioritize the things that are meaningful to them—school, sports, hobbies, work, relationships, and more.

Mr. Sciolla continued on to discuss the fact that time management will continue to be crucial to the students' success in college.

Five New Endowed Namesake Scholarships in 2023

The PSF Endowed Namesake Scholarship program continues to grow each year. Since 1998, a total of 50 namesake scholarships have been endowed in memory/honor of 48 individuals, including 20 Pennsbury graduates. Our new 2022-23 Namesake Scholarships are detailed below.

John Edwin Cebular Memorial Scholarship

Established in April 2023 by Linda Loseke

John Edwin Cebular was born in Bethlehem, PA and died in Long Beach, CA. After graduating from Pennsbury in 1963, he earned bachelor's and master's degrees from Utah State University. He built a home in Las Vegas, Nevada and his mountain-top vacation home in Beaver, Utah. Later, he was a Contracting Officer for the Department of Defense and traveled the country to negotiate contracts. He loved classical music, cooking, driving



his convertible, and visiting family and friends in Clearfield and State College, PA. John was loved by many, but his life was cut short at age 66, dying of undiagnosed melanoma. To honor John, please wear sunscreen.

<u>Joey Monaghan Memorial Scholarship</u>

Established in September 2022 by the Philadelphia 76ers & the Duffy/Monaghan Family

Joseph Charles Monaghan was a proud Pennsbury Falcon. Joey exemplified his athleticism through basketball at the age of 5 and continued to grow from there, including as captain of the PHS boys team in his junior and senior years. For two consecutive years, Joey was the recipient of the 3D Award, which is given to the player who exhibits the most Desire, Drive and Dedication. Joey also received the Rick and Chris Block Memorial Scholarship due to his character on and off the court.



Joey continued his love of basketball by playing at Marywood University. He received his bachelor's degree in Exercise Science and Nutrition in 2021 and landed a job with the Philadelphia 76ers. In his free time, he was an assistant coach of an AAU basketball team. Joey was diagnosed with a very rare form of incurable sarcoma in July 2022. He left this earth on September 22, 2022, with a legacy of kindness, strength and giving back that will never be forgotten.

Vincent Polisano Memorial Scholarship

Established in December 2022 by Pat McGinty, Bob Harman and their families, friends, & jewelry collectors

Vincent Polisano was a 1975 graduate of Pennsbury High School. He discovered his passion for jewelry making when a PHS teacher showed him how to cut gemstones. After graduating, he landed an apprentice job in the Philadelphia jewelry district. It was clear to his employer that he had a talent for the craft and was known to have "golden hands". He met his wife, Diane, in 1984, and their lives became dedicated to the love of making and designing jewelry in their Bucks County store. Throughout his many years in

business, he felt honored that the community trusted him to be a part of their milestone events with his work. Vinny loved people, life and living. He was a light on this earth and a rare human being— a real party starter! There is a great hole in all the hearts that knew and loved him, but his jewelry will live on through generations.

Robert B. Waterbor Scholarship

Established in March 2023 by the Waterbor Family

Robert (Bob) Bertram Waterbor graduated first in his class at Pennsbury High School in 1962. He earned a B.S. degree in Physics from Harvard University, and went on to earn an M.D. and Ph.D. in Psychology from Duke University, both with high honors. He remained at Duke for a residency in internal medicine, serving as Chief Resident in his final year.



Bob moved to Palm Springs in 1978 to join an internal medicine group, and then to start his own practice. Bob saw patients at Desert Hospital and Eisenhower Hospital where he was Chief of Staff renowned for solving tough cases. In 2011, Bob was named a Fellow in the American Academy of Physicians. Bob enjoyed teaching medical students and residents at Eisenhower, and at a clinic where he saw patients until he died from cancer on February 27, 2021. Bob loved Pennsbury and he would be pleased to know he is remembered through this scholarship in his honor.

Remembering Our Dear Friend & Colleague

Wanda E. Long Memorial Scholarship

Established in June 2023 by the Long Family, Friends & PSF Community

Wanda Long grew up in Randolph County, Indiana and met her husband, Harold, while attending Purdue University. They settled in Yardley, where they raised their children, Sherri and Brian, who both graduated from Pennsbury. Wanda taught Home Economics at Pennsbury and was very active in the Morrisville United Methodist Church.

Wanda joined the PSF Board of Directors in 1977 as a PTO liaison and remained on the board for an incredible 46 years. During that time, she served on various committees and positions, including five years as president. She was our historian and go-to person on a myriad of topics. Wanda was fiercely dedicated to the PSF's mission of helping Pennsbury graduates, and she was a driving force behind our Endowed Namesake Scholarship program. Her impact to the PSF cannot be overstated, and we will continue to ask ourselves "What would Wanda do?" for many years to come. The PSF Board of Directors is pleased to memorialize our friend, mentor, and colleague through this scholarship.
