Pennsbury Scholarship Foundation Awards \$150,000 to 87 Students in 2019



Celebrating the Future by Honoring Our Past

PSF President Mark Tarallo served as Master of Ceremonies for the Foundation's 19th Annual Recipient Reception in June. Attendees at the event, held in PHS West's Keller Hall, included scholarship recipients and their families, endowed namesake scholarship donor families, and the PSF Board of Directors.

Mr. Tarallo began by reminding attendees that, although the purpose of the evening was to celebrate the future by honoring our students, it was also a night to celebrate our past and realize how the past impacts our future. Like anything in Pennsbury, the PSF is deeply rooted in traditions, with a rich history.



He told the audience about former Pennsbury Superintendent, Medill Bair, the visionary behind the creation of the PSF. Mr. Tarallo then went on to talk about the William H. and

Anna C. Hayes Trust. In addition to being the source of the first sizable donation to the PSF, this endowment provided the guidelines for awarding scholarships that are still used today.

Mr. Tarallo continued his remarks by mentioning the PSF's Endowed Namesake Scholarship program, which is our way of helping families honor a loved one or keep their memory alive through future Pennsbury graduates. He mentioned that three new endowed namesake scholarships were being awarded this year, in memory of Dolores Carlen, Mark Chebra, and Judy Henke.

He continued by talking about the PSF's Donor Giving Program, which was created in 2017. This program allows donors at all levels to make gifts to the Foundation that can accumulate and result in a one-time award. In fact, two such "Medill Bair Donor Circle" scholarships were awarded this year: the Harold & Wanda Long Scholarship and the Yardley Harvest Day Scholarship.

Inspiring Achievement through Excellence

Mr. Tarallo then introduced Rev. Donald M. Schuler, Sr., a Pennsbury parent and member of the PSF Board of Directors, who spoke to the students about excellence. Rev. Schuler started by saying "excellence is not achieved in a vacuum, but rather it is achieved in the presence of others seeking to help some way, somehow."

He went on to note that excellence in giving was on display in 1955 when Medill Blair invited a group of local businessmen and community leaders to meet, talk and create the PSF. Excellence was at work in the minds of William H. and Anna C. Hayes, when they created the PSF's first large endowment, along with the award criteria of academic achievement, character, and leadership, which

were added to the PSF's guidelines.

Rev. Schuler remarked that each of the scholarship recipients had already exhibited excellence in order to receive an award from the PSF, and their award will help them continue to achieve excellence in the future. He reminded the students that, as they return home each year to the Pennsbury community, they will bring back skills and accomplishments that perpetuate excellence and inspire others to excel.

He closed by saying, "I am here to tell you that you can achieve excellence because you have. You will,

because you have done it already. Simply continue to achieve. If you believe you can, you will; if you believe you can't, you won't. Believe in the great possibilities to do great things for the purpose that your life represents."

The final portion of the Recipient Reception was the presentation of awards. Endowed namesake donor families and members of the PSF Board of Directors were on-hand to congratulate each student and deliver their awards.
